Therapist Comments:

John Doe, John Doe Sr. and Sara youth's stepmother have been very cooperative in both group and family sessions. One group was missed do to a family emergency. (this was not known to clinician until 2 days later) Probation officer was immediately contacted the next day and agreed to contact the family to ensure they would be attending the next session. Youth has had two home visits. During both home visits PLL Therapist and Case Manager met with the family for sessions. Both mother and father report that with the just the first five sessions they feel better prepared for when John will be returning home. A benchmark meeting was held and entire team was in agreement that youth can return for an early release from residential. Youth is scheduled to be released at the end of May. Community Based Action Team (CBAT) has been assembled by the CM and primary areas addressed are School (youth has already signed up for Auto Mechanic program) and part time work. CM has five applications for youth to complete and will be submitted on first week released.
