Target Population Served (Inclusionary Criteria)	<p>Risk level: Low</p> <p>Youth, ages 10 -18, who are...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In “diversion” programs, typically with status offenses, such as misdemeanors, parent files unruly or ungovernable, truancy, or curfew violations, or • First time probation offenders charged with misdemeanor offenses, such as disorderly conduct, theft under \$300, illegal consumption of alcohol by a minor, criminal damage to property, criminal trespass, etc. • <u>Not</u> in residential and have never been in residential • <u>Not</u> involved in the foster care or at risk for home removal • <u>Not</u> SED or therapized - primarily behavioral problems without mental problems such as depression, anxiety disorders, ADHD, etc. 	<p>Risk level: Moderate to High</p> <p>Youth, ages 10 -18, who are...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Charged with non-status offenses, such as felonies or high risk misdemeanors. Typical charges include aggravated battery or assault, burglary, robbery, domestic battery, running away, or drug or alcohol abuse, or • Probation violators and repeat offenders, or • Victims of abuse or neglect, or • Currently in residential treatment or returning back into community, or • In the foster care system, or designated as high risk for home removal, or • Designated as SED (Severely Emotionally Disturbed) or who have been therapized (chronic offenders on a therapist’s caseload for 6 mo -1 yr)
Average Length of Treatment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Typically 4 family therapy coaching sessions • Behavioral Contracting Only • 6 group therapy sessions 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Typically 6 to 10 family therapy coaching sessions • Behavioral Contracting + Wounds • 6 to 7 group therapy sessions
Delivery of Supervision	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One 2 hour phone supervision session per month • No video supervision required • 24/7 coverage not available unless there is an emergency 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One 1-hour phone supervision session per week, or two 2-hour sessions per month • Video taped supervision as needed using IPR (Interpersonal Process Recall) for both group and family therapy • Because these are high risk cases we are available 24/7 to answer case questions outside of regular supervision hours
Onsite Visits	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No onsite visits required 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One annual onsite visit for 2 days - live supervision and consultation
Cost Per Youth	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • \$220 per youth • License up to 128 youth/year = \$28,000 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • \$1,500 per youth • License up to 36 youth/year = \$54,000 • License up to 72 youth/year = \$108,000
